In 1990, President Bush signed into law the "Student Right to Know and Campus Security Act." This act requires all postsecondary institutions to prepare, publish and distribute certain information regarding campus

Crime Prevention Services/Education Programs

Crime Prevention Programs

The University Police Department encourages all students and members of the faculty and staff to be involved in campus crime prevention. Information on safety and security concerns and precautions are provided to students, faculty, and staff members regularly through seminars, films, bulletins, crime alerts, posters, brochures and university staff and student newspapers. In an on-going effort to facilitate this process, University Police officers provide crime prevention programs each semester on the following topics:

- 3 Rape Aggression Defense (RAD) [Self Defense for Women]
- 3 Personal Safety – Reducing Your Risks
- 3 Drinking and Driving – DUI Information

- 3 USF Police Department – Who we are and What we do
- 3 Bike Engraving and Theft Prevention
- 3 Cash Handling and Robbery Precautions
- 3 Child Safety Programs
- 3 Violence in the Workplace
- 3 Alcohol Programs

Additional programs are provided by the University to include:

- 3 All incoming first-year students learn how alcohol use impacts academic and personal success through an online education program, **AlcoholEdu** for College. During orientation, all students are exposed to information about the USF alcohol policy, crime prevention, and safety awareness.
 - 3 **Wellness USF** (www.wellness.usf.edu) offers a variety of education, prevention and awareness programs including the following:

 - Workshops and Presentations
 - Consultations on safer sexual behavior and sexually transmitted infections

 - 3 **Center for Victim Advocacy & Violence Prevention** (www.sa.usf.edu/advocacy) offers education and prevention programs on a variety of topics, including:

 - Stalking
 - Cybercrimes, identity theft, & cyber-stalking
- REAL (Relationship Equality & Antiviolence League) is a men's peer education program teaching bystander intervention techniques to prevent sexual and relationship violence (www.facebook.com/LetsBeREAL)

USF's Drug Free Schools and Community Program

The University of South Florida is committed to providing an orderly and safe environment for all students, faculty and employees. To this end, the University advises all community members that it is unlawful to manufacture, distribute, dispense, possess and/or use illegal drugs on its premises. Any violation may be cause for disciplinary action and criminal prosecution.

The use of alcoholic beverages by members of the University Community is at all times subject to the alcoholic beverage laws of the State of Florida and USF Alcohol Policy and Guidelines. Specifically, it is unlawful for any person to sell, give, serve or permit to be served alcoholic beverages to a person under 21 years-of-age or to consume said beverages on licensed premises. It is also unlawful for a person to misrepresent or misstate his or her age or the age of any other person for the purpose of inducing any license or his agents or employees to sell, give, serve or deliver any alcoholic beverage to a person under 21 years-of-age. A violation of the proceeding may be cause for disciplinary action and criminal prosecution.
